And in case my said Attorney shall not sell or transfer such certificate before the Land shall be surveyed and laid out into lots as provided in said Resolve, and ready for selection and conveyance, I further hereby authorize and empower my said Attorney to represent me before the Land Agent, and for me and in my stead to select and make choice of the lot of Land to which I am entitled, and to receive from the Land Agent a Deed and Conveyance thereof to me in fee, and after having obtained such Deed and Conveyance, I hereby further authorize and empower my said Attorney to sell and dispose of such lot of Land on such terms and conditions as he may think proper, and for me and in my name and stead to make, execute and deliver a Deed and Conveyance thereof to the purchaser, as fully as I could do if present. I Samuel Starbird of Lisbon in the County of Lincoln and State of Maine, aged about eighty years, do, upon oath declare, in order to obtain the benefit of a Resolve of the Legislature of Maine, passed March 17, 1835, entitled a "Resolve in favor of certain Officers and Soldiers of the Revolutionary War, and the Widows of the deceased Officers and Soldiers," that I enlisted in June 1777 into Capt White's company and Col Francis's regiment, Francis being killed Col. Tupper took command of the regiment for the period of three years and was honorably discharged in the year 1780 at West Point as a Sergeant having served the full period of three years & received an honorable discharge for which service I am now upon the U. S. State Pension roll of the Maine army the above service was in the map line in the War of the Revolution
I do further on oath declare that at the time of my said enlistment, I was an inhabitant of the then District of Maine

and was on the 17th day of March, 1835, have been ever since, and am now an inhabitant of the State of Maine, residing in Lisbon aforesaid, where I have resided for four formerly of Bowdoin years past. That neither I, nor any one claiming under me, has ever received a grant of Land, or money in lieu thereof, from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, for my said service, or any other service during the Revolutionary War, and that I am justly entitled to the benefit of said Resolve.
