GREETING.

IN the Name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are required to attach
the Goods or Estate of *Lilias Marsh of Crono in sd County of*
Hancock yeoman and alias Gentleman

to the Value of THIRTY DOLLARS; and for want thereof, to take the Body of the
said *Marsh* — (if he may be found in your Precinct) and him —

safely keep, so that he may be had before me, *Moses Greenleaf* — Esquire, one of
the Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid, at my Dwelling-House in *Williamstown*
— on *saturday* — the *fourteenth* — Day of *October* — at *ten*
of the Clock in the *fore* — noon: Then and there, to answer to *Francis Carr*

Joseph Carr and James Carr all of Bangor in sd County and Co Partners
in trade under the firm of *Francis Joseph & James Carr* in
a plea of the Case for that *sd Marsh* at said *Bangor* on the twenty
fifth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and seven by his note of hand of that date by him subscribed (with *two*
others) for Value recd promised jointly and severally to pay the said
Francis Joseph & James Carr or their order on demand eight dollars
with interest and that on the twenty fifth day of July in the
year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifteen *sd Marsh* at *sd*
Bangor did ~~promise~~ agree to pay the sum of twelve dollars and
ninety three cents that being the amount of Note & interest
then due & int. to be cast from that time yet the said
Marsh has after ~~been~~ requested to pay the same hath not paid
the same but neglected & refuses ~~so to do~~ —

To the Damage of the said *Francis Joseph & James* — (as he saith) the
Sum of TWENTY DOLLARS, as shall then and there appear, with other due Damages.
Hereof fail not, and make due Return of this Writ, and of your Doings therein,
unto myself, at or before the said time and day of Trial.

October — in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen
