was granted. And I do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of

the United States on the 18th day of March 1818; and that I have not since that time by gift, sale,

or in any manner disposed of my property, or any part thereof, with intent thereby so to diminish it

as to bring myself within the provisions of an Act of Congress, entitled "An Act to provide for certain

persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States, in the Revolutionary War,"

passed on the 18th day of March, 1818: and that I have not, nor has any person in trust for me, any

property or securities, contracts, or debts due to me; nor have I any income other than what is con-

tained in the schedule hereunto annexed, and by me subscribed; that my occupation and ability to

pursue the same, together with the number and other particulars of my family, are in fact and in truth

as herein particularly described, also subscribed by me.

I Joseph Tyler am embarrassed by Debts which I
am unable to pay and as I am informed they are
not taken into account in estimating my Schedule
I have omitted to enumerate them - I have no debts
due to me except what are outlanded and cannot
be collected - The reasons which have prevented me
from filing a Schedule of my property before are
as follows - I made application for a Pension as
within stated which with the proof of service were
forwarded to the War Department June 22. 1819 - No
returns ever having been made in this case to me or
my agents until recently - In 1822 I employed R. C.
Rose Esq. and our Representative in Congress to investi-
-gate the cause of this delay - The result was they
were informed my papers were duly rec^d at the office
and a Pension Certificate in my name was made
out and now remains on file in said office among
"Suspended Claims" in consequence of a Statement the
contents of which are unknown to me having been for-
warded to the War Department Adversely to my claim
I was unable to attend Court during the winter
past - at no time whatever since March 18. 1818
have I ever had in my possession of my own other
than what is contained in the within Schedule any
real estate property of any kind contracts or debts
due to me to an amount exceeding fifty Dollars
Notwithstanding I think I have a claim in equity
for past arrearages as I am very old and cannot want
a Pension long in order to obviate every objection to a
further delay I hereby expressly renounce and relin-
-quish all claims to a Pension previous to the date of
filing this Schedule
